#### **Plantations Garden Explorations**

Although the Nevin Welcome Center is now under construction, the Bowers Rhododendron Collection, Robison Herb Garden, Young Flower Garden, Ground Cover Collection, and Mullestein Winter Garden are all open to visitors. Volunteer docents will be available in the gardens and at the information table under the pergola at the Lewis Education Center. *Shuttles to the botanical garden run from the west side of Barton Hall (across from Statler Hall), on the half hour between 9:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. on Friday and Saturday.*

#### **Mundy Wildflower Garden Tour**

Cornell Plantations' native plants specialist Krissy Faust and field botanist Robert Wesley will lead this tour to explore the natural habitats, ecology, and diverse flora of the Mundy Wildflower Garden. *Shuttle departs from Barton Hall at 10:30 a.m., or you may meet at the entrance to the wildflower garden on Caldwell Road.*
